

TULSA PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The **National Register of Historic Places** is the Nation's list of cultural and historic resources worthy of preservation. It is administered by the National Park Service (NPS) of the U.S. Department of the Interior.

Properties listed in the National Register include districts, sites, buildings, structures, and objects that are significant in American history, architecture, archeology, engineering, and culture.

Within the boundaries of the greater Riverview neighborhood, there are presently **four districts** going through the National Register nomination process. They are: Riverview, Stonebreaker Heights, Buena Vista Park, and Carlton Place. The Tulsa Preservation Commission has maps of these proposed districts available.

Listing in the **National Register honors the property** by recognizing its importance to its community, state, or the Nation. Listing **does not impose restrictions** on the property or its owners. A National Register district is not the same thing as a local historic preservation zoning district. In other words, your property will not be subject to design review by the Tulsa Preservation Commission.

Becoming a National Register District is a way to identify the Riverview neighborhood as **a special and desirable place to live**. National Register listing can positively impact property values, neighborhood marketability, and homeowner pride and investment.

The National Register nomination forms and accompanying photographs can be **useful resources** for civic organizations, individual property owners, history buffs, and real estate professionals. Some day your children and grandchildren may want to know more about your home and why it's special!

The Riverview Neighborhood Association strongly endorses designation of the districts within the neighborhood and views National Register listing as a significant component in Riverview's **overall strategy for neighborhood conservation**.
